



Garden Trellis Scarf & Hat Ensemble in Tsavo



Hat Pattern

CO 54 sts.

Work in pattern stitch for one inch

Knit next row, decreasing 5 stitches across to 49 sts

Purl the next row

Knit next row decreasing 7 stitches across to 43 sts

Knit for 5 ½ inches and start crown decreases

Start decreases on a Knit side (right side) row as follows:

K5, K2tog repeat across end K1 (37 sts)

P1, *P2tog, P4 repeat from * (31 sts)

K3, K2tog repeat across end K1 (25 sts)

P1, *P2tog, P2 repeat from * (19 sts)

K1, K2tog repeat across, end K1 (13 sts.)

P1, P2tog across

Pull tail through 9 remaining stitches. Pull to snug, but not too tightly as it will pucker.

Sew seam.

Scarf Pattern

Cast on 18 stitches

Work in pattern stitch on every row until all yarn is gone, bind off.

Materials

Two 100 g. skeins of Curious Creek Fibers
“Tsavo” in desired colorway.

US #15 needles,

Size—Scarf

Hat sized for a 22” head (use a smaller or larger needle for different sized hats)

Scarf is approximately 6 inches wide and 78 inches long. To reduce or increase the width of the scarf, add or subtract the number of stitches cast on by multiples of four.

Make hat first and use remaining yarn for scarf.

Pattern Stitch

Slip 1 (knitwise), K1, *P1, YO, P2tog, K1*
(Multiple of 4+2)
